- What is the meaning of the *evangelical counsels* (obedience, virginity, poverty) today?
- How do the Ursulines organize *private property* (and inheritance)? The Australian Ursulines have the goods in common and each person gets what she needs. Some don't agree though.
- Is the destiny of the Ursulines to disagree among themselves? Is this because Angela gave individual freedom and allowed the rule to be changed...?
