EDUCATION	Each Water Woman we sponsor will receive a reliable and easy-to-use home-based filter system and the training she needs to use it well. In addition, she will receive clean water education for herself and her family. Materials in nutrition, sanitation, gardening and breast feeding are currently being developed for Water Women
HEALTH	Water is life, yet according to UNICEF, 783 million people do not have access to safe, clean drinking water. Millions of mothers watch their children suffer, even die, because of dirty water. Millions of adults and elders suffer chronic illness, and even death, because of contaminated water.
EMPOWERMENT OF WOMEN	Equipping women to improve the lives of their families and neighbors is empowering. Partnering with Water Women offers true collaboration. The Water Women take the lead, even becoming the trainers of other women in their communities.
COMMUNITY BUILDING	Trained Water Women filter water for at least three other households and educate the women of those families about clean water habits. A ministry model that draws forth women builds community. Any strengthening of community strengthens everything else.
